1. **Course Number: BIO199**  
**Course Title: Special Laboratory in the Life Sciences**
2. **Description:** A laboratory portion of existing life sciences courses that will provide a laboratory experience for only those students who are transferring in credits for life sciences courses that do not match the traditional four-credit format (3 credits lecture, 1 credit laboratory). The life sciences course laboratory selected must closely match the transferred life sciences course and must have the explicit approval of both the laboratory instructor and the Dean of the Division of Languages, Math & Sciences. Only if seating is available will students be allowed to register for the appropriate laboratory section during the ADD period. Students who transfer in more than one life science course may register twice (but, not for the same laboratory experience) for BIO199. Students with laboratory deficiencies in life sciences courses taken at CCCC will not be allowed to register for BIO199, since the life sciences courses at CCCC are designed and taught such that the laboratory and lecture are non-separable.
3. **Student Learning Outcomes (instructional objectives: intellectual skills):** Provides students with life sciences laboratory experience for transferred life sciences courses that do not meet the traditional four credit format. Laboratory student learning outcomes are dependent upon the life sciences laboratory selected.

5. **Satisfies General Education Requirement:** No.
6. **Prerequisites:** Completion of the non-lab portion of a transferred life sciences course and permission of the Division Dean.
7. **Semester(s) Offered:** Varies
8. **Suggested General Guidelines for Evaluation:** Dependent upon the life sciences laboratory selected.
9. **General Topical Outline (Optional):** Dependent upon the particular life sciences laboratory selected- approved course syllabi on file in the Division of Arts and Sciences.
